40 DAY PRAYER GUIDE

Welcome!

Thank you for joining LifePointe Church in our 40 days of prayer and fasting as we approach Good Friday and Easter.

This Prayer Guide provides 40 verses and prayer prompts that help prayer become a conversation with God. He speaks through his revealed Word, and we respond in prayer.

This guide was designed for anyone to use as a standalone resource or in addition to any other Bible Reading Plans and Devotions you may already use. The daily guide can be used in as little as 5 minutes, or could prompt a prayer that lasts hours. It can also be used in conjunction with fasting in a variety of ways. Some may also choose to abstain from other distractions for this season, such as social media or news. Fasting can help intensify our hunger for God and removing distractions can focus our attention in these 40 days of prayer.

Our prayer for you is that this resource would stir up your love for our Heavenly Father, as you engage with Him in prayer (Matthew 6:9-13).

Season of Prayer & Fasting

Join together in a church-wide season of prayer and fasting for 40 days (excluding Sundays) leading up to a special Good Friday worship service on April 7th.

Our purpose through this time is to humble ourselves before our Heavenly Father to seek His glory and leading both for LifePointe together, and for each of us individually. As you pray, please incorporate the included “Next Steps Prayer Focus” church-wide prayer requests into your prayers.

Recently during the final 2 weeks of the “Our Father” sermon series on prayer, we focused on Jesus’ instructions on fasting in Matthew 6:16-18 that are connected to his teachings on prayer.

If you missed either of these two sermons, we highly encourage you to listen to them [sharethelife.org/sermonarchives] and then consider if and how you would like to join with the church in a corporate season of prayer & fasting.

Next Steps Prayer Focus

During 40 days of prayer & fasting, pray together for the:

Nations

- Guidance and provision for those at LifePointe considering a call to the global mission field
- Davita Freeman is aiming to finish the final 8% of her fundraising by May, in order to depart for the mission field in Japan this June of 2023

Neighborhood

- Guidance for this planning phase of LifePointe's backyard renovation project - our goal is to transform the back area of the property into a space that is valuable both to our neighborhood and for the church
- Wisdom as we consider opportunities to use our building for gospel ministry that serves our neighbors with financial needs

Neighbors

- Pray by name for your own neighbors at home, work, or school; pray for boldness to share the gospel with them; pray for eyes to see opportunities that God provides to speak or show the gospel

Financial Next-Steps

- LifePointe's financial debt from the 2008 building project (Foyer, Fireside Room, Early Childhood Wing expansion, office renovation) has served its purpose well, and God is leading us forward with fresh vision for new steps of ministry!
- Pray for provision from God to move generously through His people to finish our last steps by retiring our debt, and prepare us to take these next steps together with debt-free generosity.

- How does the principle of this text apply in my life?


